The bachelor's degree in Applied Foreign Languages is a joint French-Egyptian degree with a duration of 3 years, in partnership with Université Sorbonne Nouvelle. The languages of study are French, English, and Arabic. Graduates of the bachelor's in Applied Foreign Languages can go on to study for a master's degree in France or Europe. In Egypt at UFE, they can continue their studies with the Master Multilingual Digital Marketing or the Master of International Relations.

WHY STUDY APPLIED FOREIGN LANGUAGES AT UFE?

- A 3-year trilingual professional program leading to a bachelor's degree from the Sorbonne Nouvelle University, recognized in Europe and by the Egyptian Ministry of Higher Education.
- Students enroll in Université Sorbonne Nouvelle from the first year.
- Master three languages while delving into specialized fields such as translation, economics, law, IT, communication, business, and marketing.
- Strong ties with the job market, especially multinational companies and international organizations (e.g., UN, WHO, FAO)
- Graduates pursue careers in specialized translation, e-commerce, marketing, HR, diplomacy, tourism, and journalism.
- Highly qualified Egyptian and foreign academic staff and visiting professors from Sorbonne Nouvelle University and other French universities (e.g. Université de Franche-Comté, Université Paris Cité and Nantes Université).
- Work methods enabling students to acquire professional values such as autonomy, project management, teamwork, analytical and synthetic thinking, and problem-solving.
