Overview

In the fields of languages, humanities and social sciences, UFE, in partnership with prestigious French universities, including the Sorbonne (founded in 1253), Montpellier (founded in 1220) and Franche-Comté (founded in 1423), is gradually building a range of degrees that require a minimum level of French by the time of graduation. In these fields, English is the language of instruction, with the requirement that a certain level of French be reached by the time of graduation. Students can take language tests to reach level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). In French, language certifications are national and are taken under the supervision of the Institut Français d'Égypte (IFE).

WHY ENROLL IN THE FOUNDATION YEAR ?

- In one year, reach the minimum level in French to enroll in the leading international bachelor's certificate in humanities.
- You will learn the French approach to the humanities. The Humanities component of the Foundation Year, which accounts for one-fifth of the course, is designed to provide students with the information they need to succeed at university and in their careers. It is an introduction to study that enables students to make choices between courses by providing them with elements of reflection, culture and method.
- These degrees enable students to work in Egypt's geographical environment, whether English-speaking or French-speaking (all countries of sub-Saharan Africa, the Maghreb) and Arabic-speaking (the Near and Middle East), with a French culture on the one hand and an international background on the other.
- The potential geographical employment pool is therefore immense, and trilingualism is an undeniable professional asset.
