### Position 13: Assistant Lecturer – Architecture

The Faculty of Engineering invites qualified and motivated candidates to fill the position of Assistant Lecturer in Architecture. The successful candidate will support studio-based and theoretical instruction in architecture, contributing to a program grounded in sustainable, Mediterranean, and smart-city design perspectives.

#### Responsibilities

- Support studio-based and theoretical courses in architecture — including design studios, architectural representation, building materials and construction, and architectural history and theory — primarily in French.
- Lead tutorials, desk critiques, and workshops on architectural design methods and digital tools (AutoCAD, Revit, Rhino, ArchiCAD, SketchUp).
- Assist in the preparation of studio briefs, course materials, and assessment rubrics.
- Contribute to the supervision of student design projects under the guidance of senior faculty.
- Participate in design reviews (juries), mid-term and final presentations, and portfolio assessments.
- Organize and accompany site visits, study tours, and field workshops.
- Support the integration of sustainable, Mediterranean, and smart-city perspectives into studio work.
- Pursue doctoral research in architecture, urban design, or a closely related field.
- Participate in faculty activities, exhibitions, and collaborations with French partner institutions.
- Contribute to departmental service and student advising.

#### Experience / Skills

- Master's degree in the relevant discipline or a closely related field from a recognized university; actively pursuing a Ph.D. is required.
- Teaching experience at the university level (including as a teaching assistant) is required.
- Commitment to scholarly development, with evidence of ongoing research toward the doctoral degree.
- Professional or industry experience in the relevant field is an asset.
- Strong design portfolio demonstrating studio and project experience.
- Proficiency in architectural design and BIM software (e.g., AutoCAD, Revit, Rhino, ArchiCAD).



- Professional practice experience is an asset.
- **Fluency in French is required**, with excellent command of English.
- **A good understanding of the French higher education system and ideally experience with collaborations in this field with France, would be a significant asset.**
- Excellent interpersonal, communication, and teamwork skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively with colleagues from diverse cultural and academic backgrounds.

### Application Instructions

Interested applicants are invited to submit a curriculum vitae that includes: employment history, a statement of research and teaching interests aligned with UFE's Franco-Egyptian mission, a list of publications, the names of at least three referees, and a letter of motivation. A portfolio of relevant projects is welcome.

Academic rank is assigned based on the highest degree earned, teaching experience, research output, and years of relevant experience.

Applications will be reviewed until the position is filled. For best consideration, applications should be submitted by **July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026**.
